California Art Club Award Winners

The California Art Club recently held its 98th Annual Gold Medal Juried Exhibition at the Pasadena Museum of California Art. One hundred eighty-six artists were accepted for inclusion in the show, and two artists were selected for Gold Medal honors: Daniel W. Pinkham and Aldo Casanova. Pinkham, a renowned, environmentally oriented plein air painter, was awarded the Gold Medal for Best Painting for *Enlightened*. Casanova, an 80-year-old sculptor and art professor, was awarded the Gold Medal for Best Sculpture for *Sky Emblem*. Also receiving awards at the show were Dennis Doherty, who won the Edgar Payne Award for Best Landscape Painting for *Opalescence*, and Jove Wang, who received the Guy Rose Award for Best Multi-Figurative Composition, for *A Day at Silk Road*.
